NZS3910, which contains the 'rules' for administering and managing civil engineering and building contracts, was revised in 2023. However, many contracts will continue using the 2013 conditions.

To assist newcomers understand the rules and to provide a refresher for more experienced people, this course provides an overview on how to manage and administer contracts and to understand their obligations and liabilities under the 2013 version of NZS3910.

- Understand the issues for all three parties - the Principal, the Contractor and the Engineer to the Contract
- Understand 'extension of time' and associated implications and costs
- Understand payment processes and retentions

Who should attend?

The course is suitable for people working in contracts that use NZS3910: 2013 version. It will benefit those who have little or no experience with NZS3910, as well as those who already use it. The course is designed for people involved with contracts in the building,

construction, utilities, landscaping, civil engineering and roading sectors, as covered by the Construction Contracts Act 2002.
